Application procedure for admission to Master's Programs at the University of Tsukuba (UT): Special selection for Double Degree Program between University of Grenoble Alpes and University of Tsukuba

If you wish to enroll in our Degree Program from Academic Year 2026, apply according to the following procedure.

1. Choice of suitable program

A few applicants will be selected. Please be sure to verify the research areas of your interest, available on the website of the Degree Program, and contact your desired faculty advisor and obtain his/her consent to your application prior to submitting your application for the examination.

2. Eligibility for Admission

Student in Master's program or its equivalent program of the University of Grenoble Alpes

3. Fees & Tuition

There will be no examination fee, admission fee, or tuition fee for this special program.

4. Security Export Control

The University of Tsukuba has established the University of Tsukuba Rules on Security Export Control in accordance with the Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Act, and conducts strict examinations for acceptance of international students. International applicants who fall under any of the conditions set out in said regulations may be unable to enter their desired course or program.

- (2) Examination type and allocated points: **Oral examination (200 points)**
- (3) Content of Oral Examination: Individual interview. It focuses on your major field of study, etc.

- 2. Your application will not be evaluated if the above documents are incomplete or not accurately completed. Applications received after the deadline will not be processed.
- 3. Before applying, you have to contact a prospective supervisor (a faculty member from whom you wish to receive academic instruction) and obtain their consent to your application in advance.

The University of Tsukuba uses the entrance examination results and other personal information that it obtains from application documents only for matters related to admissions and screening or to improve its admission processes and education systems.
