Regarding the special tuition exemption for academic year 2026, eligible candidates are recommended as follows for students enrolled in the second year of the master's program in the Degree Programs in Pure and Applied Sciences who are aiming to advance to the doctoral program in the Degree Programs in Pure and Applied Sciences.

1. Recommendation requirements

Students enrolled as of April 1, 2026, in the second year of the master's program (master's course) of the Graduate School of Science and Technology, Degree Programs in Pure and Applied Sciences (including students admission in October 2025), who plan to advance in the following academic year to a doctoral program equivalent to the Degree Programs in Pure and Applied Sciences, and whose research achievements are outstanding.

3. Amount of exemption

The amount of the special tuition exemption shall be the full amount of the second-semester tuition for the students eligible for the exemption.

4. Documents to be submitted

- (1) Special tuition exemption Application Form (for equivalent to the master's program)
- (2) Student Transcripts
- (3) Career Preference Statement
- (4) Other (as required by each degree program)

5. Submission deadline and submission destination

Submission deadline: Monday, September 14, 2026, 15:00 (strictly observed)

Submission destination: Follow the instructions of each degree program
